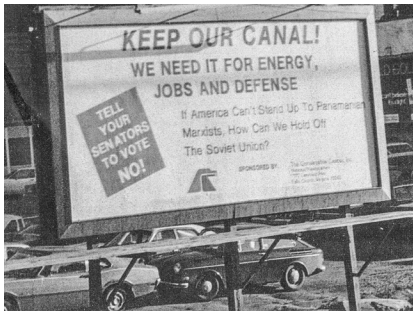

What happened to conservatives in 2020 and 2022? ...and what can we do to make sure it doesn't happen again?

Why were the results so disappointing and, in many cases, so contrary to expectations and downright weird? We believe there's one explanation that best fits the evidence.

Changing the rules changes the outcome of a game, in sports or business or politics. For example, the adoption of the secret ballot in the 1890s reduced turnout by about 10% because people were no longer as likely to be bribed or intimidated into voting. A person's vote was now hidden. That change affected voting patterns.

We believe that relatively recent adoption of **mass early voting and mass mail-in voting** changed the nature of elections. Changes that were supposedly made necessary due to the pandemic, but that were retained indefinitely, added perhaps **three points** to the Democrats' total – not necessarily because of fraud, but because the Left has a well-oiled political machine at the grassroots level almost everywhere. Conservatives and their allies (including pro-Free Speech liberals) are not sufficiently organized to beat the Left at this game.

How important is three points? With an extra three points, **Democrats would have won every presidential election since 1988.**

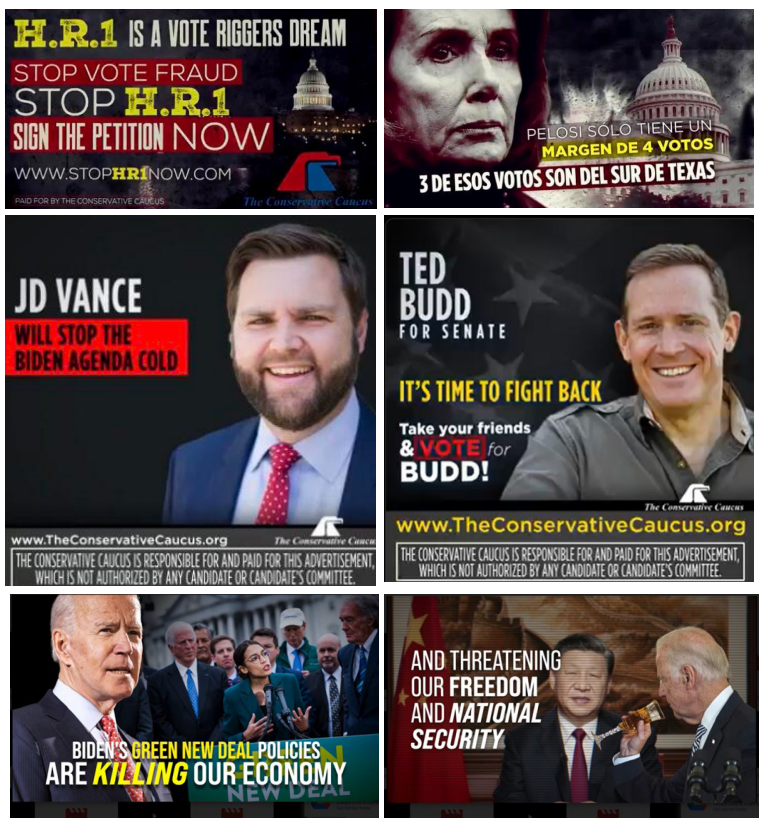
We can complain about the unfairness of these new rules, but, in most places, they will stay in place until we can do something about them... and we can't do something about them until we win!

If the good guys are to survive, much less thrive – if we are to save this country from the threat of extremism and authoritarianism – we must adapt to the new rules by building a political machine that can match the one the Left has, so that every single voter on our side sees his or her vote **cast and counted.**

To make sure that that occurs, TCC is organizing in **every congressional district**, including the ones that have been challenges for conservatives in the past. It's a daunting task, but this isn't the first time the Caucus has built a grassroots network across the country. A few years ago, when TCC Chairman Peter Thomas was field director, we had chapters in 225 districts. We can do that again, bigger and better.

To build this network, we need your help to recruit TCC members and chapter leaders, to obtain the resources we need, and to spread the word about what TCC is doing.

Today, our freedom is under attack like never before in our lifetimes. To turn back this threat, we must *organize* as never before. The Conservative Caucus is doing its part. Will you join us in this effort?
